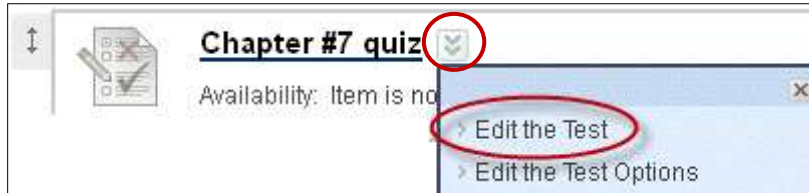


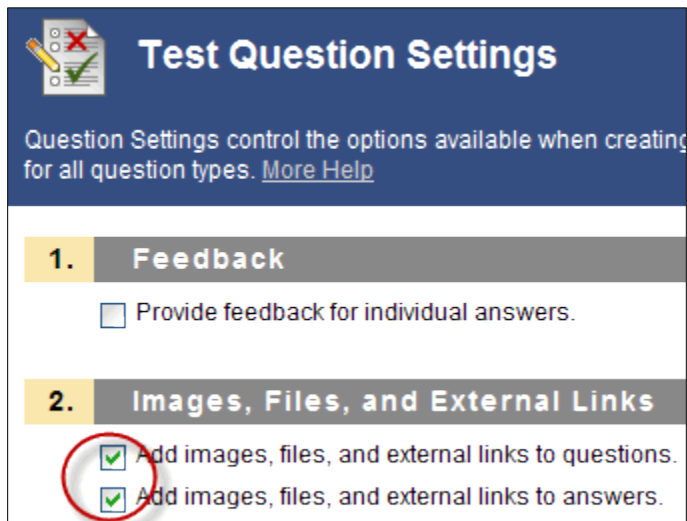
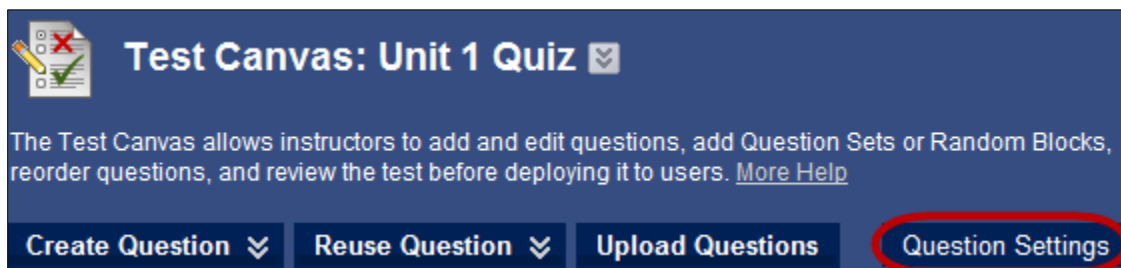
## Re-link Missing Test Images in Blackboard

If you can see your test images, but your students cannot, you may need to re-link the images.

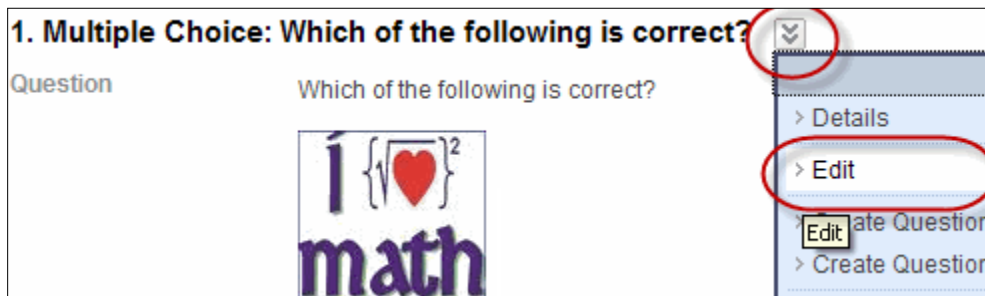
1. Identify and edit the test that has image problems:




2. Adjust the question settings for each affected quiz:



3. Scroll to a question that has an image issue. Select **Edit** from the action menu:



4. Delete the image from the text field. Upload the correct picture:
